Film, Television and Media Arts is the study of film, television, video, and new media technology. It combines elements of the visual and performing arts with writing, speech, computer science, theory, history, technology, criticism, literature, law, psychology, sociology, and management in the production of visual and aural communications. FTMA explores the broadening implications of producing media for new wider Internet and evolving distribution opportunities.

Program Student Learning Outcomes

- Students will utilize Production Books to communicate the design, acquisition and post production requirements to their team members in order to produce complete motion picture productions.
- By undertaking a comprehensive video production students will participate in a collaborative environment that promotes the sharing and evaluation of creative contributions.
- Students will demonstrate their understanding of fundamental preproduction, production and post-production concepts by completing a three to five minute video project which will integrate camera, lighting, sound and editing techniques.
